Membership Application

On receipt of a completed application form, the membership quota will be reviewed. Instruction to make payment of membership fees will be provided when the current membership quota criteria are met.

Payment of membership fees is required prior to confirmation of membership. Payment can be made via:

The membership application administration fee is non-refundable.

Once membership is approved, subscription fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Membership Definitions

Senior Member

A senior member is over 18 or turns 19 between the 1st of January and the 31st of December in the year of application or renewal of membership.

Junior Member

A junior member is under 18 or has their 18th birthday between the 1st of January and the 31st of December in the year of membership application or anniversary.

Family Membership

Discounted available to family of 2 adults and up to 2 juniors living at the same address.

Out of Town Membership

Discount available to members who live outside an 80km radius from the club rooms at time of application or membership renewal.

Membership Approval

All membership applications require acceptance of the committee and may be subject to membership quota established due to limitations of club resources. New members will be notified of application status on receipt of this application by the club's administrator. Approval will be acknowledged via delivery of induction information and clubroom access key, if applicable.

Membership Renewal

Membership is renewable annually. An invoice will be issued which is due for payment on the anniversary of the membership approval and/or storage provision. Failure to make timely payment of membership and/or storage fees due may result in:

- Loss of access to club facilities – key administration fee of \$25.
- Termination of membership – membership reinstatement will require payment of \$20 application fee.
- Impoundment of Stored Equipment.
- Sale of impounded equipment to cover unpaid fees.

Membership Resignation/Termination

Membership resignation/termination must be notified in writing. Key deposit will be refunded on return of the key within 90 days of notification of resignation/termination. In the event that a key is not returned, it will be permanently removed from the Club's key register.

Storage of Kayaks

Storage of boats is at owner's risk. The Arawa Canoe Club cannot be held responsible for damage or theft of equipment from the clubrooms or storage sheds. It is recommended that owners discuss appropriate cover with their insurance provider. Please respect other club members' equipment by taking care when handling boats in and around the sheds and by ensuring that sheds are locked when unattended. A condition of storage is that your boat will have a small sticker applied near the rudder. This allows us to check storage is up to date and all members can easily identify a boat that is not in the correct space.

Use of Gym Equipment

The gym is available to facilitate training for club members as a part of their strength and conditioning development to enhance their paddling performance. The gym is not for the use of non-paddling members.
